Field Trip—Ohio & Erie Canalway and

the Centennial Lake Link Trail

Ohio Department of Natural Resources Director Mary Mertz will lead a walking tour of a portion of the Ohio & Erie Canalway and The Cleveland Foundation Centennial Lake Link Trail. The trailhead is a short walk from the Renaissance Hotel at the terminus of the Ohio & Erie Canalway. The Canalway is a National Heritage Area designated by Congress in 1996 to help preserve and celebrate the rails, trails, landscapes, towns and sites that grew up along the first 110 miles of the canal that helped America grow. Annually, more than 2.5 million people find their way to the iconic 87-mile trail running through the heart of the Canalway. The walking tour will include interpretive

speakers at key sites on the trail.
